1. Welcome and Introductions

Chaffey College –Ariel Sales; Chaffey Adult – Sandra Palmerin; Chino Valley Adult – Bev Hatch; Upland Adult – Erica Cisneros; Dana Galloway – WECC

2. Summer, Fall, Chaffey College dual enrollment update

Laura Alvarado sent a report that there are 27 students enrolled in summer partnership classes from CAS and FAS. This is a decent number, all things considered. Fall registration has just opened.

Chaffey College transition data match project

Ariel Sales described the progress she is making with the data match, and that it would be interesting to include placement information to see which levels the adult students are taking. She does not currently have access to this information but will work on getting the necessary permissions. Ariel pointed out that online vs. in-person statistics may not be valid for 2019-20, as spring semester classes that started in-person ended as virtual.

- CAEP summary tables (Dana)
CAEP tables indicate that FAS and CVAS are doing a good job with post-testing. CAS and UAS hope to post-test more students by the end of the semester.

Back on contract for 3-Year Plan Dana explained that Greg Hill Jr. will not specifically work with the Data Group next year, but he can help us out on projects related to the 3-Year Plan. This is a wide umbrella, so we would have access to his expertise and resources.

Principals/Directors are considering which programs should continue online and which ones may open in person. Regardless of what districts may mandate, adult students “vote with their feet” and will not return if schools do not meet their needs. Online ESL is a big question. Right now it is difficult for adult students with school-age children to return in person, as most elementary schools are in a hybrid or cohort mode.
