2. Chaffey College transition data match project (Ariel Sales)

Ariel reported that she is making substantial progress on the data match and will share the report next week after Matt Morin has seen it. She will request data from the group as needed.

Chaffey College dual enrollment program (Laura Alvarado)

Laura reported the dual enrollment (SB554) numbers are as follows (enrollments, not completions):

Fall 2020: 42

Spring 2021: 70

Sum. 2021: 31

Fall 2021: 58

She also reported that the college is working on a new non-credit application that will be easier for students to navigate.

3. Round table: School updates; topics of interest/concern; questions

Chino Valley: The student population is currently about half of what it was prior to the pandemic. HSE/HSD programs are online but all ESL and other programs are in-person. CASAS testing is being held on the campus.

Fontana: There is no online ESL, only HSE/HSD.

Upland: They are looking for ESL teachers so they can re-open sections and expand the program. There is an online ESL class in the evening; nothing currently in the morning. There seems to be little interest in a Citizenship class.

Chaffey: Many ESL students want to return to the classroom, but others have acquired new technology skills and prefer to remain online. The ESL numbers are down but the HSE/HSD programs have held their own. The CASAS locator is being used to place students into ESL classes and pre-/post-testing is taking place in labs or classrooms.
